Within the frameworks of the “Women, Families, Careers – Effects of the Pandemic on Work/Life Balance in the Visegrad Countries” Project we are organizing the Multiplying Event / International Conference in Budapest on 8th March 2022 which will be in hybrid form with the participation of our V4 and Hungarian Partners, including the relevant target groups, stakeholders, and decision makers through the network of our partnership.

Within the framework of our Project, we have examined the impact of the pandemic on four special groups of women (mothers with children, women who are planning a family, women over 50, and rural women), in particular with relation to the labor market.
